Quigley's Ireland Tour Itinerary

Sunday, April 23 DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Monday, April 24 DUBLIN ARRIVAL

After landing at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Stop to have breakfast with your group at a local restaurant or pub before continuing towards Kilbeggan to visit the Kilbeggan Distillery, which was established in 1757 and is one of the oldest licensed distilleries in the world. While here, enjoy a tour and tasting of the finished product. Next, journey into Galway and embark on a panoramic tour to see the principal sights of the city. See the Spanish Arch in the Claddagh area, the City Museum and the Cathedral of Our Lady, which is built on the site of the former county jail. Motor a short distance to your hotel, check in and settle into your room. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Tuesday, April 25 CONNEMARA SIGHTSEEING

This morning, travel through the Connemara Region to admire the sweeping views of boglands and misty mountains. As you drive along you will see many sheep that graze freely and tracts of bogland where some people hand-cut peat for home heating. Stop at Kylemore Abbey for a tour of the elegant mansion and church, set beside a tranquil lake. Learn of the tales of tragedy, romance and royal visits. Also, walk through the magical Victorian walled garden. Head back to your hotel in Galway, where the balance of the day is free for independent activities and dining.

Wednesday, April 26 BUNRATTY FOLK PARK

Leaving Galway, journey into Bunratty to visit the Bunratty Folk Park, which comprises a collection of farmhouses from different regions of Ireland. Also, see a 19th century village street with a pub, school, general store and many other buildings where traditional lifestyles and crafts are demonstrated. Then, continue your drive into Killarney, check into your hotel and enjoy some free time before dining with your group in the hotel restaurant.

Thursday, April 27 DINGLE PENINSULA DRIVE

Today, discover the beauties of the Dingle Peninsula, once described by the National Geographic Traveler as "the most beautiful place on earth." Drive along the south shore of the peninsula for plenty of vistas

of heathery mountains, sandy stretches of beach, stunning green landscapes and rocky headlands. Pause at strategic locations to admire the views and take photos. Return to your hotel in Killarney and spend the rest of the day free to sightsee, shop and dine on your own.

Friday, April 28 KILLARNEY TO CORK

Departing Killarney, enjoy beautiful scenic views as you drive along Healy's pass and into Cork. Upon arrival, set off on a panoramic tour of the main areas of Ireland's second largest city. Cork is built on many hills with many steeply sloping streets. See Shandon Church, which dates to 1722. Also, view the Gothic-revival St. Finbarr's Cathedral, named for the patron saint of the city. Motor a short distance to your hotel, check in and settle into your room. Tonight, you may like to dine independently in one of the city's lively dinner venues.

Saturday, April 29 DUBLIN SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, travel through Ireland's rolling hills into the bustling city of Dublin and set off on an orientation drive around the city center. See the main thoroughfares of O'Connell Street, Nassau Street and some lovely public parks as you pass by many historical sites. Transfer to your nearby hotel, check in and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure. This evening, meet your group for an early dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Sunday, April 30 HOP-ON, HOP-OFF DUBLIN

Also using your voucher, you may visit either EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum, the GPO Museum, Guinness Storehouse or Teeling Distillery. If you choose to visit EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum, learn about the celebratory dramatic story of the spread of Irish culture around the globe, and how Ireland has changed throughout the years. If you decide to visit the GPO Museum at the General Post Office on O'Connell Street, learn about its role in the Easter Rising and how it was left in ruins. Finally, if you choose to visit the Guinness Storehouse or Teeling Distillery, enjoy a tour of the distillery and tasting of the finished product. Tonight, you may like to dine in one of the many restaurants or pubs that Dublin has to offer.

Transfer to Dublin Airport in good time to check in for your flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying back to the United States.
